Whew! I've registered!

Now what happens?

What's the Board doing?

Immediately after the last registration date, your board begins the process of putting the teams together for the upcoming season. When this is completed, the uniforms will be ordered and the coaches will be notified.

When do the coaches get their teams?

Coaches should expect to receive their team rosters at their division meeting in *early August*.

When do the players get called?

Teams may begin practice on or after *August 13*. The coaches will call the players usually from early to mid August. They will give you all the information you will need in regards to practice times and location. Each coach sets his/her own practice days, time and location. The practice fields are located throughout *El Segundo*.

It's after August 13 and my child has not been called. What do I do?

Please do not panic if you see teams practicing and your child has not been called. Not all teams begin practice at the same time. The very young teams, in particular, do not always begin practice on *August 13*. Also some coaches may be out of town. If your child has not been called by

August 27, you may leave a message at 310-322-9760.

What else does my child need?

The registration fee includes: a complete uniform (jersey, shorts, socks), supplemental accident insurance and team and individual pictures. In addition, you may need to obtain soccer shoes, shin guards, a soccer ball (size depends on age) and a water bottle, if you don't already have them.

How often are practices and games?

Practices for the older divisions are usually held twice a week (days and times to be determined by your child's coach) while the younger divisions usually practice once a week. Games will mostly be on Saturdays with the first game on *September 10*. Games for the U5 and U6 divisions are at *Brett Field*. Games and practices for the U7 and U8 divisions are at *Richmond Field*. Games and practices for the U10 and older divisions are primarily at *Campus El Segundo*.

Refund?

Players withdrawing prior to *September 1* will be issued a full refund. On or after *September 1*, no refunds will be issued without board approval (refer to our Region Refund Policy). All requests for a refund must be

submitted in writing and accompanied by a self-addressed stamped envelope. Deliver this to the *Regional Registrar*.

Late registration?

Late registration begins after our last registration event on *June 11*. Those interested may call *our Regional Registrar* at 310-322-6014 or email at gundogirl@aol.com. Players registering after 1 pm on June 11 are put on a wait list.
